To make your own Bible Reading Box:

1. Purchase or obtain a small container (jar, box, etc.) for each student.
 2. Make enough copies of the instructions below so you have one per student. We have included multiple copies of the instructions so you can cut them apart and include them with each Bible Reading Box.
 3. Make enough copies of the books of the Bible list on the next page—one per student.
 4. Cut each sheet into the 66 slips and place in each container.

Instructions for the Bible Reading Box

1. Pray first and ask God to choose the book in the Bible that he wants you to read next.
 2. Select a piece of paper without peeking. This will be the first book you read.
 3. Put the slip back in the container. (God may have you read this book again.)
 4. Read a portion of the book each day until you are finished.
