

Standard for Leadership

4. I exercise the basic disciplines of the Christian life, including regular prayer and Bible reading.
5. I am a member of my church (unless I am actively seeking a new church home) and regularly attend worship services barring illness and vacations.
6. I tithe faithfully and consistently.
7. I have taken (or am currently taking) *Healing Journey* and applied the tools to my own life.
8. I embrace the truth and in my ongoing journey believe that:
 -) God is my provider, protector, and source of power.
 -) God is who he says he is.
 -) God will do what he says he will do.
 -) I am who he says I am.
9. I have willingly made the choice to:
 -) Allow God into any and every wounded area of my heart.
 -) Actively use all of the healing steps to work through my individual garbage.
 -) Live victoriously, not as a victim.
 -) Be accountable to the team for my choices.
