Holy Spirit: A Beautiful Part of our Walk with Jesus

Scriptural Texts:

Genesis 1:26; Isaiah 9:6; Matthew 10:19-20; 28:20; John 6:63; 14:26; 16:13; Acts 1:8; Romans 8:26; Hebrews 2:4; 1 John 3:24

Main Points:

1. From the beginning of time, God has existed in 3 parts: God the Father, Jesus his Son, and the Holy Spirit.
2. God is and will always be a subject vaster than the human mind can completely comprehend.
3. When we become a child of God, receiving Jesus into our heart, the Holy Spirit automatically comes and lives inside us.
4. Pride doesn't vacate the premises (our life) just because we're God's child and we have the Holy Spirit. We continue to fight against our pride.
5. God calls us out from billions of people on earth, speaking our name and words of encouragement, correction, and direction.
6. Read your Bible and expect that God will speak to you.
7. The difference between God's voice and Satan's is that Satan speaks in condemning tones that tear us down. God speaks with love, even if it is a word to correct the way we're going.
8. When we ask, listen, and wait, the Holy Spirit will give us discernment in our decisions.
9. Nine ways the Holy Spirit helps us: #1 he directs our steps. #2 He gives us the right words at the right time. #3 The Spirit give us life. #4 The Holy Spirit is our teacher and counselor. #5 He brings truth and shows us the things of God. #6 The Spirit helps us pray and prays for us. #7 He makes God's fruit part of us. #8 He gives us spiritual gifts. #9 The Spirit gives us discernment.

1. What are some ways you find your pride in a battle with the Holy Spirit?

2. Read point #9. In which of these would you like to experience more of his help? Describe a situation or relationship where this would be beneficial. Begin praying for this.

3. What can you do to better respond to God's Spirit living in you?
