Leaving Egypt: Why is it Hard to Leave Our Bondage?

Scriptural Texts:

Isaiah 43:1-21

Main Points:

1. Reasons we stay in Egypt and don't travel with God to the Promised Land include: fear it will be unfamiliar, and fear it will be uncomfortable, difficult, and scary.
2. When we don't trust God, we get stuck in the wilderness.
3. God has proven his faithfulness to us and his believability by sending his Son to die in payment for our sins. He has redeemed us.
4. God loves us and knows us intimately. We are highly valued by him.
5. We do not need to be afraid because God promises to be with us every step of the way.
6. To make the journey with God, we need to know him and believe him.
7. It is in the process of trusting God that he reveals himself to us.
8. God promises to make a way through our desert, even if we can't see any possibility of a way.
9. God's plan for us is to take us to a place we will feel content, where we will thrive.
10. It's in the journey that we will be made new, not in the deliverance.

Questions:

1. Where do you see yourself on your journey with God? In Egypt, Letting-Go Wilderness, or in the Promised Land? Explain.

2. What fears tend to keep you stuck?

3. List a few promises from Isaiah 43 that increase your faith and give you courage to trust God?
