Zechariah 7:10; Matthew 12:25; John 13:34-35; Acts 24:16

#### **Main Points:**

- 1. God desires that his children be recognized by their love for others.
- 2. The "us against them" mentality is divisive, fostering hatred and broken relationships.
- 3. Divisiveness is Satan's goal, never God's.
- 4. God sees beauty and goodness in every person, because he is our creator.
- 5. It is the work of God alone, to reach into a mind or soul, and turn on a light of truth and salvation.
- 6. Hatred and judgment never led anyone to Jesus.
- 7. At every person's core are the same needs for love, nurture, acceptance, significance, belonging, freedom, security, and respect.
- 8. We must learn to separate sin from the sinner, as Jesus does with us.
- 9. God will always supply any amount of love we need.
- 10. Change starts inside us, with our heart, beliefs, and acceptance of truth.
- 11. Bitterness causes unending wreckage in every direction.
- 12. Prayer needs to precede actions of restitution and reconciliation.
- 13. Obedience to God means attempting reconciliation whenever we can.
