Podcast Worksheet Leaving Egypt: Why is it Hard to Leave Our Bondage?

Scriptural Texts:

Isaiah 43:1-21

Main Points:

- 1. Reasons we stay in Egypt and don't travel with God to the Promised Land include: fear it will be unfamiliar, and fear it will be uncomfortable, difficult, and scary.
- 2. When we don't trust God, we get stuck in the wilderness.
- 3. God has proven his faithfulness to us and his believability by sending his Son to die in payment for our sins. He has redeemed us.
- 4. God loves us and knows us intimately. We are highly valued by him.
- 5. We do not need to be afraid because God promises to be with us every step of the way.
- 6. To make the journey with God, we need to know him and believe him.
- 7. It is in the process of trusting God that he reveals himself to us.
- 8. God promises to make a way through our desert, even if we can't see any possibility of a way.
- 9. God's plan for us is to take us to a place we will feel content, where we will thrive.
- 10. It's in the journey that we will be made new, not in the deliverance.

Questions:

- 1. Where do you see yourself on your journey with God? In Egypt, Letting-Go Wilderness, or in the Promised Land? Explain.
- 2. What fears tend to keep you stuck?
- 3. List a few promises from Isaiah 43 that increase your faith and give you courage to trust God?
