Scriptural Text:

Acts 8:1a; 9:1-19; Romans 9:32; Galatians 1:15-18a

Main Points:

- 1. God was offended and hurt that Saul was following the wrong belief system.
- 2. God had been trying to get Saul's attention about his false beliefs, but Saul resisted him.
- 3. God is always pursuing us with his love and his truth.
- 4. After his encounter with Jesus, Saul allowed his beliefs to be altered, surrendering his pride.
- 5. It is important we allow Jesus to have regular access to our thoughts and beliefs.
- 6. It is God's normal mode of operation that he strips away the false before he puts the new truth in place. The transition time in between is extremely uncomfortable.
- 7. Until we receive Jesus and his Holy Spirit, we are blind. Only in Christ can we see truth.
- 8. Once God did a redemptive work in Saul, then all his natural zeal and passion could be unleashed to change the world.
- 9. One of the biggest paradigm shifts Saul needed to make was from works-based salvation to grace-based salvation. He had to know even his sins were forgiven by Jesus.
- 10. In order for Saul to allow God to work through his life, he had to reject many lies about his identity such as: *There is no way God can use me after what I've done. God could never forgive me for all the terrible things I've done. He can't use me!*
- 11. Before Saul could begin his new assignment, he had to: humble himself, listen to God, accept he had false beliefs, and accept God's love and grace were big enough to use even him.

Questions:

- 1. Think about Saul's uncomfortable transition from following the wrong beliefs to following the One True God. In what ways can you relate?
- 2. List any false beliefs that cause you to struggle today.
- 3. Do you believe without hesitation that God loves you and desires to use your life, even considering sins you've committed? If not, can you identity the lies you are believing? Take a moment to admit these things to God and receive his healing.

Prayer of Response:

Lord God, please move the Holy Spirit in me to show me where I am still attached to false beliefs. I give you access to my heart and mind. Help me surrender my pride and walk in humility before you. I want to know the joy of serving you and living in the plan you have for my life. In Jesus name, amen.
