Main Points:

- 1. In order to grow in closeness with the Lord, we need to grow in our understanding of him.
- 2. Because God is the embodiment of holiness and perfection, he is worthy of our respect.
- 3. Everyone needs a Tent of Meeting, a place to regularly meet with God.
- 4. To make excuses as to why we can't make daily time with God is the behavior of a victim, and a sure way to guarantee our defeat.
- 5. Keeping everything we need for our daily time with God together in one place will encourage our success.
- 6. Just as Moses needed to spend time with God in order to live the life God planned for him, so we need to do the same.
- 7. The benefits of regular time with God are many, including helping us to be prepared, equipped, encouraged, strengthened, as well as having access to God's direction and healing.
- 8. We continually need a fresh word from God in order to stay on Trust Trail.
- 9. God wants us to be devoted to him, not devoted to rules and laws.
- 10. To succeed in the life to which God has called us, our relationship with him needs to be primary.
- 11. God's Word washes us, keeping us clean and free of problem areas.
