



Virtual Healing Journey Class Checklist

To lead a virtual class you must be comfortable with computers, webcams, streaming videos and technology in general. We are not able to assist with technical support for virtual classes.

1. Pray and ask the Lord if it is His will for you to lead a virtual class. Don't move forward until you feel he is directing you to do so.
2. Prepare yourself to lead.
 - Attend Boot Camp training if possible
 - Purchase a Small Group Leader's Guide (available at hishealinglight.org)
 - Purchase a Training DVD (available to stream on our website)
 - Purchase a subscription plan for streaming lessons or a DVD set
3. Be sure you have the proper equipment. You need access to a computer with the following:
 - A processor of 2 GHz or faster
 - 4 GB RAM or greater
 - A high speed internet connection with a connection speed of 1.5 MB/s or better.
 - Keyboard and Mouse
 - Speakers/Headphones and Microphone
 - A web camera capable of video web conferencing
4. Determine which platform you will use for your class.
 - gotomeeting.com, zoom.com, Skype and Facebook Messenger are a few options
 - Keep in mind that some platforms charge a fee. You may need to increase registration fees to cover this cost.
 - Be sure you can broadcast the lessons through the platform you choose.

Additional information:

- Virtual classes will be 30 weeks instead of 29 to allow for one night of technical set up and orientation.
- Virtual classes should have no more than seven students.
